


Tips to Protect Your Identity at Home



- Establish Text Alerts to help Fight Fraud
- Run an Antivirus scan periodically
- Enable 2 factor authentication on personal accounts
 - Configure Privacy and Security and Login settings
- Report Phishing and Spam
 - Forward Text Scams to 7726 (SPAM)
- Create strong passwords
- Secure your connection Look for HTTPS
- Keep devices and computers up to date




Report Phishing and Spam — Personal Outlook






Report Phishing and Spam — Personal Gmail






