When: Proposals are due to the Honors College by November 8. Conference takes place April 12-15, 2012.

Honors College students who are currently in good standing are eligible to submit proposals for the 2012 Northeast Regional Honors Council Conference. The theme of the conference is "Competing Claims: Divisions and Coalitions," and participants are invited to examine the concept of competing claims and the divisions and coalitions that have resulted from that dynamic interaction in the arts and humanities, social sciences, business and technology, natural and applied sciences, and education. However, proposals are not required to align with the conference theme. Students are encouraged to present research or creative projects that they have already completed in one of their honors courses. Presentations can be in the form of papers, posters, and student-led interactive workshops.
