## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Do I need a TU ID to ride the shuttles?

For the off campus shuttles yes, a valid TU ID is required. An ID is not required to ride the on campus shuttles (Gold and Black Routes).

### Is there any cost for using the shuttle services?

No, TU's on and off campus shuttle services are free to TU students, faculty, and staff.

### Do the shuttles operate on the weekends, during summer/winter breaks, and when the University is closed?

During the academic year, only the Tiger Shuttle and Safe-Ride operate on weekends. During the breaks (summer, winter, holiday) and when the University is closed no shuttles are in operation, except the Para-Transit on a limited basis.

### How do I know when the shuttle is coming?

In addition to schedule information available in the bus shelters throughout campus and on the Parking & Transportation website [www.towson.edu/parking](http://www.towson.edu/parking), you can use your mobile device or computer to find out how long it will be until the next shuttle arrives by visiting <https://www.nextbus.com> and selecting your route & stop.

### Do the shuttles operate in bad weather?

Unless the University is closed due to inclement weather and provided that road conditions allow for safe operation, the shuttles will be operating on their normal schedules during the academic year.

### Can I bring guests with me on the shuttles?

For the on campus shuttles, yes you can. A valid TU ID is required to ride the off campus shuttles. During certain large events this restriction is lifted. Daily Digest announcements will be used to inform the campus community of these occurrences.

### Can transportation be requested for charter service to various destinations?

Yes, transportation services can be arranged. Please note that charter services do have a cost associated with them. To request charter services please visit <http://www.towson.edu/adminfinance/auxservices/parking/charters.asp>.

### **Safe-Ride & Police Escort**

- If you do not feel safe walking on campus late at night Safe-Ride is a perfect option. If you are at an inaccessible location for the shuttle, TUPD can provide you with a walking escort
- Free Safe-Ride point-to-point service is provided during the academic year when the Gold Route, Black route, and Tiger Shuttle are not in operation on weekdays, 2:30 AM-6:00 AM and from 9:00 PM-6:00 AM on weekends

### **Para-Transit**

- Free Para-Transit service is provided on campus for those with mobility needs who are registered with Disability Support Services
