

“NOTICE OF THE ANNUAL CLERY CAMPUS SECURITY REPORT”

In accordance with the guidelines established by Towson University and pursuant to federal law, identified as the *“Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998,”* all currently enrolled students, campus employees and all prospective students and prospective employees are entitled to request and receive a copy of the Towson University Annual Campus Security Report (CLERY REPORT). The report contains crime statistics about certain specified crimes/incidents that have been reported to the Towson University Police Department and/or Campus Security Authorities over the past three years and have occurred either on-campus, in off-campus buildings or property owned or controlled by the University, or on public property adjacent to campus.

The report also contains policies and practices pertaining to campus security, crime reporting, alcohol and drugs, victims’ assistance programs, student discipline, campus resources, community safety alerts, crime prevention, access to campus facilities/properties as well as personal safety tips. The report encourages the reporting of all crime occurrences. The report describes how and to whom to report crimes.
