File > Publish Does Not Work

Error:

"I created my website offline and when I got to File and click on Publish, FrontPage will not let me publish my website to the internet. How do I get it to publish?"

Solution:

1. **Save** your work elsewhere. Copying and pasting the files to your hard drive may work best.
2. **Exit** FrontPage.
3. **Open** FrontPage.
4. Click **File > Open Site**.
5. Enter your **username and password**.
6. Click **Open**.
7. **Copy** the files you saved elsewhere (See Step 1).
8. **Paste** all files into the toolbar on the left.
9. Click **Save**.

All your files have been published to the internet and saved.

FrontPage Keeps Asking Me For My Username and Password

Error:

"After clicking File > Open site, FrontPage keeps asking me for my username and password. What happened?"

Solution:

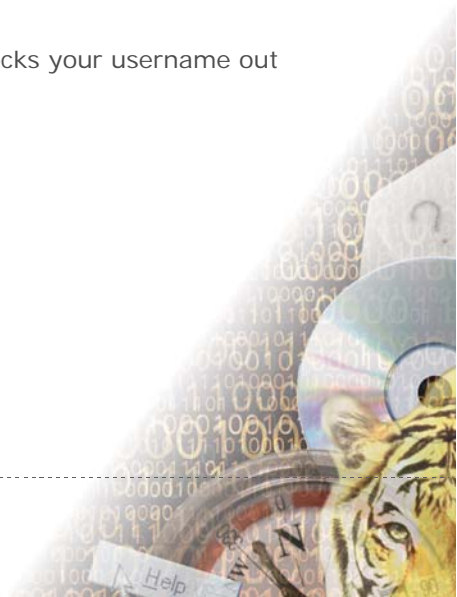
If you enter a wrong password three times, Towson University locks your username out of all of its services for 30 minutes.

You can either:

- **Wait** 30 minutes.

OR

- **Call** the faculty Help Center, 410-704-5151.



What is my URL?

Problem:

“When I go to **File > Open site**, FrontPage asks me for my “Site name”.
What is my site name?”

Solution:

Your site name is the URL of your website.

1. Students: Type `http://tiger.towson.edu/~username`
 - **Example:** `http://tiger.towson.edu/~jdoe1`
2. Faculty/Staff: Type `http://pages.towson.edu/username`
 - **Example:** `http://pages.towson.edu/jdoe`

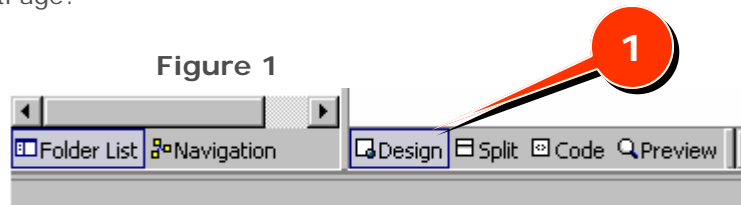
I Can Not Edit My Website.

Problem:

“Why can’t I edit my website inside FrontPage?”

Solution:

1. Make sure you are in design view.
2. Click the design view button at the bottom left corner to enter design view (**Figure 1, 1**).



FrontPage Double Spaces My Type

Problem:

“While typing in FrontPage, my text seems to be double spaced even though it says in the settings under **Format > Paragraph** the line spacing is single. How do I stop it from double spacing?”

Solution:

To fix this problem, hold the **Shift** key and press **Enter**. This will move you down one line instead of two.
