



Vice President James P. Sheehan

As Vice President for Administration and Finance at Towson University, James P. Sheehan is responsible for the senior-level management of Fiscal Planning and Services, University Police, Facilities and Construction, Human Resources, Technology Services, and Auxiliary Services. He oversees the university's \$308 million operating budget and \$360 million capital budget project.

In his role as Vice President, Mr. Sheehan serves on the President's Council and represents the university's interests before the state legislature. He serves as a member of the University Senate and the University Foundation Board of Directors. He is a member of the Greater Towson Committee and belongs to both the National and Eastern Associations of College and University Business Officers.

Mr. Sheehan has over twenty-five years of experience in higher education. He came to Towson in January 2006 after serving as Vice President of Administration and Finance at Edinboro University of Pennsylvania for eight years. Mr. Sheehan received a B.S. in Accounting from Bentley College and an MBA from the University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth.
