

Tobacco Free Campus Task Force Recommendations

Goal: To continue to further promote a “Clean, Safe (healthy), Pretty & Happy” campus by implementing a tobacco free policy effective December 31, 2010.

Rationale: All members of the campus community are entitled to clean air. The effects and potential danger of second hand smoke is well documented. Additionally, members of the TU community have made great strides in maintaining a clean campus. One of the biggest ongoing challenges to this is litter generated from smoking. This policy will support campus community principles of creating a respectful environment.

Proposed Policy:

Smoking and the use of tobacco products is prohibited across the Towson University campus. This includes all buildings and interior spaces on the Towson University campus, including University housing as well as all exterior spaces including spaces adjacent to buildings, sidewalks and street ways, parking locations within the perimeter of York Road, Cross Campus Drive, Osler Drive, Towsontown Boulevard, and Burke Avenue.
