Students enrolled in TU's graduate Judaic Studies and Jewish Professional programs have access to BHI's need- and merit-based scholarship and fellowship opportunities.

**Scholarship application information and due dates
for 2010-2011 BHI Scholarships:**

- Merit scholarship will be determined by the scholarship committee.
- Need-based scholarships will meet Towson University criteria for need, and will be given based on ranking by TU Financial Aid office.
- Students receiving fellowships and scholarships from BHI are expected to help with BHI events, and write thank you letters to donors.

Procedures for applying for scholarship:

- To apply for Merit Scholarship:
 - Submit a written request to the BHI office stating your intent to apply for Merit Scholarship.
- To apply for Need-Based Scholarship:
 - File FAFSA with the Towson University Financial Aid office
 - Submit a written request to the BHI office stating your intent to apply for Need-Based Scholarship.

Deadlines:

- All requests by **current students** for scholarship for the Fall 2010 / Spring 2011 school year must be received in the BHI office by **April 15th**.
- All requests by **new applicants** to Towson University's Judaic Studies graduate programs must be received in the BHI office by **June 1st**.

Requests by current students received after April 15th will not be considered.
