

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND DUE DATES **2011-2012 BHI SCHOLARSHIPS**

BHI is committed to supporting the education of Judaic scholars, educators, and communal professionals who exemplify excellence in their chosen fields. Students enrolled in TU's graduate Judaic Studies and Jewish Professional programs have access to BHI's need- and merit-based scholarship and fellowship opportunities.

Scholarship application information and due dates for 2011-2012 BHI Scholarships:

- Merit scholarship will be determined by the scholarship committee.
- Need-based scholarships will meet Towson University criteria for need, and will be given based on ranking by TU Financial Aid office.
- Students receiving fellowships and scholarships from BHI are expected to help with BHI events, and write thank you letters to donors.
- Students receiving Merit scholarship must maintain a GPA of 3.5 or higher, and must take 2 or more courses per semester.

Procedures for applying for scholarship:

- Merit Scholarship
 - Submit a written request to the BHI office explaining your qualifications for a Merit Scholarship.
- Need-Based Scholarship
 - File FAFSA with the Towson University Financial Aid office
 - Submit a written request to the BHI office explaining any special circumstances that should be considered along with the TU Financial Aid office FAFSA ranking.

Deadlines:

- All requests by **current students** for scholarship for the Fall 2011 / Spring 2012 school year must have been received in the BHI office by **March 22nd**.
- All requests by **new applicants** to Towson University's Judaic Studies graduate programs must be received in the BHI office by **June 1st**. *

Requests by current students received after March 22nd will not be considered.

- Exceptions will be made for students entering a Judaic Studies program after June 1st.
