SIDE B.**TRANSFER GUIDELINES**1. **Petition to Evaluate the Course Equivalency of a Transfer Course:**

Immediately submit a "Petition for Acceptance of Transfer Credits" form (only used for CBE required courses) to the CBE Student Center, ST112. Provide a course description from the transfer institution for evaluation. (details on the form)

2. **Transfer with less than a "C" (i.e., a "C-" or "D")**

A grade of "C" (2.0 QPA) or higher must be earned in all courses required for the major. Repeat the course at Towson for a grade of "C" or higher. An additional 3 credits will be required for a graduation (i.e., a minimum of 123) to replace the duplication of the transfer course.

3. **Validation Required:**

Validation means that the course taken as lower-level at a community college or four-year college cannot transfer to TU as upper-level credits (e.g., if you transferred a lower-level Principles of Marketing course, it appears as MKTG41 instead of MKTG341 on your TU transcript.)

To Validate: Complete a specified course in the same discipline with a minimum grade of "C" or grade equivalent of 2.0. For example, after you earn a "C" or higher in MKTG445 (MKTG341 is the prerequisite for MKTG445), you will have validated the transferred lower-level marketing course.

Do NOT register for TU's MKTG341 if you have completed MKTG41 with a grade of "C" or higher. You must validate the course, not repeat it. The same policy applies to MNGTT61 for MNGT361, and MNGTT81 for MNGT381. If you complete the course at Towson, it will be considered a **duplication of transfer credit** and you will need an additional 3 credits for graduation (i.e., a minimum of 123.)

4. **Transfer Credit Policies:**

Transfer students must complete at least 30 hours of upper-level credits in CBEC, EBUS, ECON, FIN, LEGL, MKTG, and MNGT at Towson for the BUAD major.

Only **"one"** transfer course will be accepted for a Concentration/Track.

REQUIREMENTS for ADMISSION to the BUAD MAJOR:

- A minimum cumulative quality point average (QPA) of 2.0 or higher for all coursework.
- A minimum quality point average (QPA) of 2.40 for ALL seven lower-level BUAD Core prerequisites, with a minimum grade of 2.00 or higher in each of the lower-level *BUAD* Core prerequisites.

Application Procedure

If you will meet the admission requirements at the end of the semester, complete an "Application for Admission to the BUAD major" and a change of major declaration form before registering for upper-level "majors only" CBE courses (CBEC/BUSX, EBUS, ECON, FIN, LEGL, MKTG, and MNGT.)

The application forms are available in the Cornerstone-Professional Experience Office, ST 117, and the CBE Student Center, ST 112.

Course Requirements: A pre-business (PBUA) student who does not meet the admission requirements and enrolls in an upper-level BUAD (CBEC/BUSX, EBUS, ECON, FIN, LEGL, MKTG, or MNGT) course without written approval by his/her advisor, will be disenrolled from the course.
