## Creating Your Degree Completion Plan (DCP)

Minimester $1+$ Last 2 digits of year (ex: 15 for 2015) $+1=1151$
Spring $\quad 1+$ Last 2 digits of year (ex: 15 for 2015) $+2=1152$
Summer $\quad 1+$ Last 2 digits of year (ex: 15 for 2015) $+3=1153$
Fall $\quad 1+$ Last 2 digits of year (ex: 15 for 2015) $+4=1154$

Registration Tip: Prerequisites are checked online as you register. A pre-business (PBUA) student who is not accepted to the BUAD major and enrolls in an upper-level CBE (BUSX EBTM, ECON, ENTR, FIN, FPLN, LEGL, MKTG, or MNGT) course will be disenrolled from the course.

## REQUIREMENTS for ADMISSION to the

 Business Administration (BUAD) MAJOR:- A minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher for all coursework.
- A minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.70 for ALL seven lower-level BUAD prerequisites, with a minimum grade of 2.00 or higher in each of the lower-level BUAD prerequisites.
- Successfully complete the Computer Proficiency Exam (CPE) OR EBTM 250 with a passing grade


## Admission Procedure:

At the start of each semester and before registration, the CBE Student Academic and Career Services office will notify PBUA students of their admission status by e-mail to their Towson e-mail address. Students who have met the requirements in effect for their catalog year will be automatically admitted to the major and will be eligible to take upper-level "majors-only" CBE courses.

Students who take upper-level "majors-only" CBE courses before being admitted to the Business Administration major do so at their own risk.
