Admission Procedure:

Admission to BUAD major will be processed after grades are posted in a term. Students may register for "majors only" courses <u>after</u> admission to the BUAD major has been processed by the Registrar's office (expected times are: Mid-January; late-January; early June; & approx. 3 weeks after summer sessions).
