Application Procedure

- Applications are due in the EMF office no later than March 6th **at 3pm**.
- Students may apply for more than one (1) scholarship. However, each scholarship requires a separate application (each application requiring 3 copies of materials). Be sure to consult the attached scholarship list for eligibility requirements.
- Decisions will be announced March 20th.

- **3 collated and stapled/bound copies of ALL print application materials (i.e. application form, essay, and transcript) are required at the time of submission (only one copy of the audiovisual work or creative/critical writing is needed), the committee will NOT consider applicants who fail to provide copies**

All applications should include:

- Three copies of this completed form (see reverse)
- Three copies of a complete unofficial transcript
- Three copies of an essay covering:
 - Fredericks: why the applicant wishes to pursue a career as a filmmaker
 - Levinson: the applicant's merit and academic achievement
 - O'Connor: the applicant's academic merit and demonstrated, sincere interest in radio broadcasting
 - Robinson: the applicant's merit and financial need
 - Rogers: the applicant's merit and financial need
 - Sidorowicz: the applicant's academic achievement and talent in their field of study
 - WTMD: the applicant's merit, promise of success in the radio profession, and history of involvement with WTMD if any
- One copy of audiovisual portfolio work (DVD or CD formats accepted only) OR creative/critical writing demonstrating applicant's merit is required for all scholarships

II. The Barry Levinson Scholarship Fund

- declared EMF or Pre-EMF major
- junior or senior status by Fall 2009
- 3.0 GPA or higher
- award based on demonstrated academic achievement
- Award amount: TBA

III. The O'Connor Scholarship

- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- award based on merit and demonstrated, sincere interest in radio broadcasting
- two awards will be given
- Award amount: \$959 each

IV. The Michael J. Robinson Scholarship Fund (two scholarships will be awarded)

- outstanding talent in their field of study
- award not renewable
- Award amount: \$500

- sophomore status by Fall 2009
- demonstrated promise for success in the radio profession
- preference given to students who work or volunteer for WTMD
- financial need is a possible consideration
