<b>Requirement (24 total units)</b>	
<p>1. Honors English: ENGL 190 or ENGL 290 (3 units) <i>Students who receive AP or transfer credit for English 102 must take ENGL 290.</i></p>	<p>ENGL _____</p>
<p>2. Honors College Courses (15 units)</p> <p>a. Honors College Seminars (minimum of 9 units) <i>All courses that satisfy the seminar requirement are indicated each semester on the Honors course schedule posted on the Honors College website. Students who fulfill their Honors English requirement may take ENGL 290 towards seminar requirements, as long as the student does not repeat ENGL 290 with the same topic (maximum 3 units).</i></p> <p>b. Honors Coursework <i>Most students take Honors versions of courses (i.e., Honors Introduction to Psychology, Honors Acting, etc.) to fulfill this requirement, but any honors course that does not already satisfy other Honors College requirements may be used to fulfill this requirement.</i></p>	<p>Sem.: _____ Sem.: _____ Sem.: _____ _____ _____</p>
<p>3. Honors Electives (6 units) <i>Each student must complete an additional 6 Honors units toward Honors College course requirements in the following Honors course options: Departmental Honors; Honors Independent Study; Honors Directed Readings; Honors Internship; Honors Independent Investigations; Study Abroad; Upper-level Honors College Seminars; Honors Capstone; Honors Thesis.</i></p>	<p>_____ _____</p>

**Notes:**

A single Honors course may only fulfill one requirement at a time. (For example, ENGL 290 cannot count towards both the Honors English and the Honors seminar requirements at the same time; however, students may take ENGL 290 twice to fulfill both options, as long as the course has a different topic each time.)

Requirements for Good Academic Standing and continuation in the Honors College:

1. Cumulative 3.3 GPA in all Towson University courses.
2. Cumulative 3.0 GPA in Honors courses.
3. Successfully complete 6 Honors units by the end of the first year of study, 12 Honors units by the end of the second year, and 18 Honors units by the end of the third year.

Students who fall below the requirements for good standing will be placed on Honors Probation for at least one semester, and they will become academically ineligible to participate in the Honors College if they fail to return to good standing by the end of the probationary period.

The pass grading option is not available for Honors courses taken to fulfill requirements for the Honors College. (Students are allowed to switch an Honors course to the pass grading option, but it will no longer count towards their Honors requirements.)
