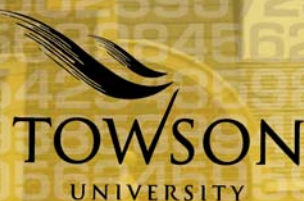

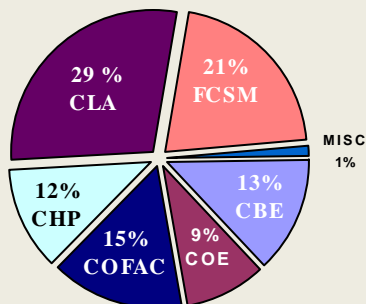

Total Credit Hours by College

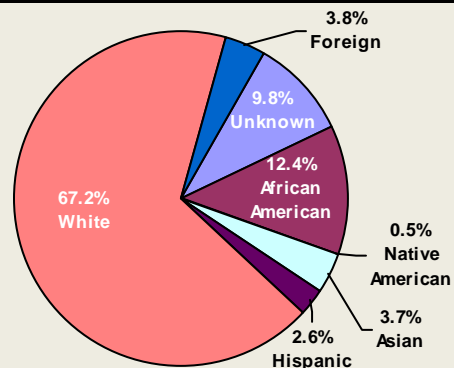
