

**Undergraduate Program
Estimate of Expenses for 9 months
for Academic Year 2007-2008**

Staying in the U.S. during the summer and taking additional courses will be extra. Also note that some students may be required to pay additional academic and other special fees, depending on their area of study (such as private music lessons, technology or lab fees, fees when certain majors are declared).

\$17,182	Tuition/Fees: \$8,591 each semester for 12-15 credit hours per semester (required minimum of F-1 undergraduate students) X 2 semesters= \$17,182. This is an estimate*.
\$8,318	Room and board: Estimate* based on current cost (2006-2007 year) of \$2,250 each semester for shared double room plus \$1,749 per semester for a 14-meal plan (does not include summer room and board) X 4% increase.
\$900	Books & Stationery/Supplies
\$877	Health insurance and expenses: The 2006-07 rate was \$384 for fall and \$459 for spring, or \$843. A 4% increase would bring the new rate to \$877.
\$2,185	Personal expenses: approximately \$193/month X 9 months (\$1,737) in addition to \$450 (\$15/day X 30) for meals during minimester. The monthly living expenses based on students' responses to surveys include: \$53 Recreation and other meals \$63 Phone \$46 Clothing and shoes \$0 Transportation (living on campus or nearby) <u>\$27</u> Toiletries, laundry, and supplies \$189 X 2% increase = 193
\$29,462	Total (\$17,182 T/F plus \$12,280)

We'll round off to:

\$17,200	Tuition and fees
<u>\$12,300</u>	Living expenses
\$29,500	Needs to be verified for issuance of I-20

*Board of Regents January 2007 approval still subject to change. Final decision usually made in late spring.

Note: \$7,500 is the assigned value for room and board being provided by a Baltimore area sponsor.

Note: Additional financial documentation must be shown to bring a spouse: \$6,500 (and \$3,500 for one child; additional children \$2,500 each) per year.
