In fall 2021 TU is planning to return to a face-to-face environment in alignment with our mission, values, purpose, and accreditation.

Faculty at Towson University are members of a community of scholars, and it is in this sense of community that we best serve our students, our colleagues, and the State of Maryland. Being physically present to participate directly in the life of the campus is a critical element of creating and sustaining a successful academic community.
