




## Financing Your Education in the Freshman Transition Program (FTP)

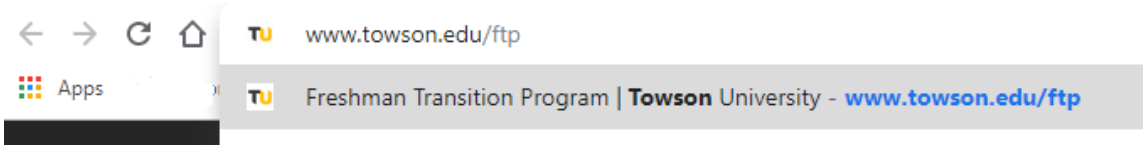
- Step 1** - Complete the FAFSA application online ([www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov))
  - Make sure to use the **CCBC school code (002063)**
  - Do not remove the Towson University school code (002099)
  - You will receive a Student Aid Report (**SAR**) electronically. Review it carefully and correct any errors. Take note of your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) and estimated Pell Grant award
  
- 
 **Step 2** – Redirect Maryland State Aid
  - If you are a Maryland Resident, use the MDCAPS system (<http://mdcaps.mhec.state.md.us>) to inform the Maryland Higher Education System **that you will attend CCBC** rather than Towson
  
- Step 3** – If you have been selected for verification, submit verification documents
  - You will be notified by e-mail if you have been selected
  - Any needed documents will also appear on SIMON – <https://simon.cbcemd.edu>
  - Verification Worksheets are available on [www.towson.edu/ftp](http://www.towson.edu/ftp)
  
- Step 4** – Direct all private scholarship funds to CCBC’s Bursar’s Office, **NOT** Towson University.
  - Complete and submit the Private Aid Information Worksheet ([www.towson.edu/ftp](http://www.towson.edu/ftp)) to inform us of this award
  
- Step 5** – Use the Expense Worksheet ([www.towson.edu/ftp](http://www.towson.edu/ftp)) and your FAFSA **SAR** ([www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov)) to determine how much loan money you may need
  - Submit the PAPER Student Loan Application ([www.towson.edu/ftp](http://www.towson.edu/ftp)) to apply for a student loan. FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS **CAREFULLY**
  - Submit the PAPER Parent PLUS Loan Application ([www.towson.edu/ftp](http://www.towson.edu/ftp)) to apply for a Parent PLUS loan. FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS **CAREFULLY**

**ALL FINANCIAL AID DOCUMENTS/APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO CCBC: DUNDALK BY 7/25/24 IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE 8/1/24 BILLING DUE DATE**

- Step 6** – Pay any remaining balance to CCBC Bursar’s Office
  - All of your primary expenses (tuition, fees, room, and board) will be paid through CCBC. Only incidental expenses (parking expenses, library fines, etc.) will be paid directly to TU
  - You will receive your first bill in early/mid July  
**\*\*DO NOT WAIT TO RECEIVE THIS BILL TO BEGIN SUBMITTING FINANCIAL AID DOCUMENTS! BEGIN AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE\*\***
  - Payment instructions, billing due date and payment plan information will be included
  - CCBC offers a monthly payment plan if you prefer to break up your expenses


**If you owe a balance that is not covered by financial aid and you fail to make alternative payment arrangements to pay your FULL balance in a timely manner, your schedule will be dropped and your enrollment in the program will be canceled.**
