Only incidental expenses (parking expenses, library fines, etc.) will be paid directly to TU Step 6 – Pay any remaining balance to CCBC Bursar's Office All of your primary expenses, library fines, etc.) will be paid directly to TU You will receive your first bill in early/mid July **DO NOT WAIT TO RECEIVE THIS BILL TO BEGIN SUBMITTING FINANCIAL AID DOCUMENTS! BEGIN AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE** Payment instructions, billing due date and payment plan information will be included CCBC offers a monthly payment plan if you prefer to break up your expenses 	
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If you owe a balance that is not covered by financial aid and you fail to make alternative payment arrangements to pay <u>your FULL balance</u> in a timely manner, your schedule will be dropped and your enrollment in the program will be canceled.


