

Introduction

Your total aid from all sources (including loans) can't exceed your assigned **Cost of Attendance** budget, which is normally based on these [Standard Cost of Attendance budgets](#), but if your actual housing costs are higher than these standard allowances, you can ask us to increase your housing budget allowance based on your actual house costs.

How could increasing my budget change my aid?

Budget increases usually only increase your maximum loan amounts, and usually only for these loan programs: [Parent PLUS](#), [Graduate PLUS](#), or [private loans](#).

Budget changes usually don't increase [Federal Direct Subsidized & Unsubsidized Loans](#) because most students already qualify for these maximum amounts based on their standard budgets.

Budget increases rarely increase grants or scholarships because most students already qualify for their maximum annual grant/scholarship amounts based on their standard budgets, and budget changes will never increase Pell Grants. Budget increases can only change grants or scholarships if your original amounts were reduced because your total aid exceeded these [Award Reduction rules](#).

Request Instructions

- 1) We can only increase your housing budget if you pay more than \$7,632 for 9 months (\$848/month). We can't increase your housing allowance if you live with your parent(s).
- 2) Complete and submit the attached form.
- 3) It may take us up to 6 weeks to process your request.
- 4) When processing is complete, we will send a notification to the students' TU email account.
- 5) **If you want to borrow additional loan funds** based on your revised budget, **you must submit another [Parent PLUS](#), [Graduate PLUS](#), or [private loans](#)** application to request the additional loan funds.
We can't increase just your existing PLUS or private loans.
- 6) You must enroll **at least half-time** for each semester that you borrow loans.

If you will pay more than \$7,632 for 9 months (\$848/month) for your on or off-campus housing, you may submit this form to request a housing budget increase.

If your request is approved, after your budget is increased, you can **reapply** for additional loan funds.
