TU Priority Deadline: Submit your FAFSA by **2/1/2023**. MHEC Deadline: Submit your FAFSA by **3/1/2023**.

You must meet these deadlines to apply for additional aid from TU and the *Maryland Higher Education Commission (MHEC)*. If you missed these deadlines, apply **now** because you can still apply for Federal grants and loans.
