

Certified Clinical Medical Associate Program Externship

The Towson University Continuing and Professional Studies Certified Clinical Medical Associate Program is partnering with Johns Hopkins Community Physicians on the externship program.

Requirements

- The externship is a required component of the CCMA program and should be completed within 2 months (8 weeks) of start date
- 160 total hours
- Students must commit at least 20 hours a week to their extern site. It is strongly recommended that
 externs set a schedule of 28–40 hours a week to make the most of the experience and opportunity
- Certificates of completion will be distributed electronically upon successful completion of the externship hours

Requirements for placement

Students must meet the following requirements:

- Completion of clinical program (108 hours) and self-paced learning (250 hours)
- Be 18 or older with a high school or GED® diploma
- Basic Life Support for Health Care Providers (BLS) certification (included in program)
- Proof of vaccination:
 - ♦ Measles (Rubeola), Mumps & Rubella (MMR)
 - ♦ Varicella (Chicken Pox)
 - Hepatitis B
 - ♦ Tuberculosis (TB)
 - ♦ Influenza (Flu)
- Health insurance
- Criminal background check
- Drug screening (basic urine 9-panel)

Placement

- Through email communication and virtual office hours, the extern coordinator will learn more about your interests and type of placement students seek.
- Students will be matched with an office based on fit and flexibility.

The externship is a required component of this course.

Certificates of completion will be distributed electronically upon successful completion of the externship hours.
