**Policies:**

1. Students are allowed a maximum of two attempts for all courses. A course taken for a third attempt will not fulfill the minor requirements unless PRIOR written approval is obtained from the Academic Standards Committee.
2. All minor courses must be completed with a grade of 2.0 or higher and a minimum GPA of 2.0.

**Recommended Course Sequence**

The minor may be completed over four semesters.

Recommended	Courses
<b>Semester 1</b>	• FIN 331
<b>Semester 2</b>	• FIN 350 • FIN 333
<b>Semester 3</b>	• FIN 351 • Elective 1
<b>Semester 4</b>	• Elective 2

*Note: FIN 331 is a junior level course and is a prerequisite for all other FIN courses. FIN 350 is a prerequisite for FIN 351, FIN 430, FIN 436 and FIN 439. FIN 333 is a prerequisite for FIN 423 and FIN 433.*
