APPEALS PROCEDURE

- Students must first discuss the issue with the faculty member involved. (The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

 (http://www2.ed.gov/policy/gen/guid/fpco/ferpa/index.html) does NOT allow specific student record matters to be discussed via
 e-mail or telephone. Also, specific student record information may not
 be discussed with parents or others without first getting a signed
 statement from the student explicitly stating the information that may
 be discussed and the specific timeframe for the release of this
 information.
- 2) If the situation is not resolved with the faculty member, students may bring their concerns in writing (signed and dated letter, including a return U.S. mailing address) with attached documentation to the department chairperson prior to, or during, a meeting with the department chairperson. The faculty member will be contacted by the department chairperson to discuss the issue.
- 3) If a meeting with the department chairperson does not resolve the situation, students may take their concerns to the College of Health Professions Dean's Office.
