Course topics include institutionalized heterosexism and homophobia, Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender (LGBT) identities, communities, culture, and political activism. Not open to students who have successfully completed IDIS 101 or LGST 101. Core: Diversity and Difference or Gen Ed II.C.3 (3 credits)

Introduction to research-informed guidelines for working with lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender families in professional settings. Will explore LGBT families and relationships. Ways to help LGBT families and youth thrive will be emphasized. Promotes in-depth understanding of the systemic context of LGBT families and lends itself to application of knowledge in diverse professional contexts. Prerequisite: FMST 101, FMST 102, PSYC 101, or SOCI 101. Core: Diversity & Difference. (3 credits)

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SEX DIFFERENCES: PSYCHOLOGICAL PERSPECTIVES (PSYC 447) SEX DIFFERENCES: PSYCHOLOGICAL PERSPECTIVES

Sex role/personality development is examined from various perspectives: social, cultural, evolutionary, and biological. Changing conceptions with regard to women, their roles and self-concepts, are emphasized within the overall context of sex differences and similarities in behavior. Prerequisites: PSYC 101 and PSYC 203. (3 credits)

A survey of relevant research literature under the guidance of a staff member who will direct the student's research. May be repeated for 6.0 units. Prerequisite: 6 hours of course work in the LGBT minor or consent of instructor. (1-3 credits)

INTERNSHIP IN LGBT STUDIES (LGBT 485) – Special Permit Only

Supervised internship experience in the field of LGBT Studies under the direction of a faculty member. May be repeated for a maximum of 9 units, but only 6 units can be applied to the LGBT minor. Prerequisite: 6 units of course work in the LGBT minor or consent of instructor. (3-6 credits)

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READINGS IN LGBT STUDIES (LGBT 581) – Special Permit Only

A survey of relevant research literature under the guidance of a staff member who will direct the student's research. May be repeated for a maximum of 6 units. Prerequisites: 6 units of course work in the LGBT Studies minor or consent of the instructor. (1-3 credits)
