




First, check the prerequisites.

 - Journalism internships.

Check in with your personal and professional contacts.


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
Once you've gotten the internship:

Complete the online approval form found on the dept. website.

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Things to remember:

You will need an MCOM faculty advisor

This faculty advisor will oversee your internship and will go over expectations. You should meet with them once your internship has been approved.

Course Assignments

You will need to complete the internship course assignments (MCOM 460 or MCOM 461) from your faculty advisor as well as from your work-site supervisor.

Each credit hour equals 40 hours of work at the internship.

In order to earn 3 credits, you must log 120 hours.

Keep track of your hours and evals

You will need a supervisor to sign off on hours you worked and to fill out a mid–semester and end of semester evaluation.
