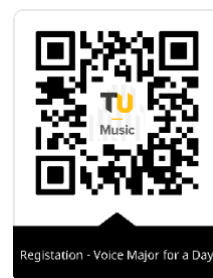


Voice Major for a Day 2026

What is required:

1. This is a free event, but **registration is required of all students & parents.**
2. Parking permits are required to park on campus at Towson University. The closest and cheapest lot to the Center for the Arts is Lot
3. All registered students who wish to sing on the 12:30 masterclass must have a *memorized* solo song (art song, musical theatre, opera, folk song arrangement, American Song Book - *no excerpts from a piece composed for choir please*).
4. All songs must have piano accompaniment. Students are requested to perform the song with one of Towson’s staff pianists.

Other Information:

1. A tour of campus and the Center for the Arts will depart from the Grand Hall in the Center for the Arts at 10:30 a.m. If you wish to take this tour, please arrive in the Grand Hall no later than 10:20 a.m.

2. You are encouraged to eat lunch or a hearty breakfast before you arrive for registration *or* bring a bag lunch that you can eat before the 12:00 noon welcome meeting. Snacks will be available at the 3:00 p.m. Q&A.
