Adjunct (Part-time) Instructor in Applied Voice

Adjunct Professor of Music – Applied Studio Voice

Position: Adjunct professor to teach applied studio voice to undergraduate and graduate voice majors in performance, music education, liberal arts music majors, music minors, and non-majors. Teaching of voice methods (voice class) possible. Tenor, baritone, bass preferred. Other courses such are possible based upon the candidate's qualifications. Position begins fall 2019 pending need.

Qualifications: Master's Degree [minimum] in voice performance. Previous classroom and teaching experience at the University level required. Evidence of an active performance career required. Diversity, equity and inclusion are high priorities for Towson University, applicants must articulate and demonstrate how they address these institutional priorities in all aspects of their teaching and as a faculty colleague.

Duties: Teach private applied lessons and weekly master classes. Attend juries and student recitals. Attend monthly Voice Division meetings. If assigned, teach voice methods (voice class) for music education instrumentalists. Work as a collaborative team member to support the Voice Division and its activities.

Application Process: Review of applicants will begin immediately and continue until filled. Submit electronic letter of application and a current CV along with an active/functioning web address to a video/audio sample of approximately fifteen minutes of the candidate's solo performance to:
