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| <p>1. Foundations Courses (6 units)</p> <p>a. Honors English: ENGL 190 or ENGL 290 (3 units) <i>Students who receive AP or transfer credit for English 102 must take ENGL 290.</i> <i>Students who join the Honors College after completing 30+ credits and ENGL 102 (or equivalent) are exempt from this requirement.</i></p> <p>b. TSEM 190 Honors Towson Seminar (3 units) <i>Students who have already earned credit for TSEM 102 are not required to take TSEM 190. Those who have earned fewer than 30 credits must take an additional 3 units of Honors Coursework instead. Those who have earned 30-59 college credits but not credit for Honors English are exempt from this requirement, while those with 30-59 college credits who have earned credit for Honors English must to take an additional 3 units of Honors Coursework instead. | <p>3. Upper-Level Honors Seminars (6 units) <i>HONR 370 may be repeated for a maximum of 15 units provided a different topic is covered each time the course is taken.</i></p> | <p>_____</p> <p>_____</p> |
| <p>4. Experiential and Advanced Learning Courses (6 units) <i>The following course options may be completed to meet this requirement:</i> HONR379 Honors Independent Study; HONR490 Honors Study Abroad; HONR491 Travel Study Honors; Upper-level Service Learning courses; HONR493 Honors Internship; HONR495 Honors Directed Readings; HONR497 Honors Independent Investigations; HONR499 Honors Thesis; Departmental Honors; Upper-level Honors College Seminars; Honors Capstone (only certain departments). <i>All options in this category, with the exception of Honors seminars, must be approved by the Honors College before enrollment for that term. Students are required to present the results of their work in this category (except 300-level Honors seminars) at least once per 3 units at a Celebration of Scholarship and Learning or other event approved by the Honors College.</i></p> | <p>_____</p> <p>_____</p> |

Notes:

- A single Honors course may only fulfill one Honors requirement at a time; e.g. one section of ENGL 290 cannot count towards both the Honors English and the Honors seminar requirements; however, a student may take ENGL 290 twice to fulfill both options, as long as the course has a different topic each time.
- No courses may fulfill requirements for the Honors College if taken using the pass grading option.
- ENGL 290 may be repeated for a maximum of six units, as long as the student is enrolled in different topics.

Requirements for Good Academic Standing and continuation in the Honors College:

1. Cumulative 3.3 GPA in all Towson University courses;
2. Cumulative 3.0 GPA in Honors courses;
3. Successful completion of at least 6 Honors units by the end of the first year of study, 12 Honors units by the end of the 2nd year, and 18 Honors units by the end of the 3rd year.

Students who fall below the requirements for good standing will be placed on Honors Probation for at least one term and will become academically ineligible to participate in the Honors College if they fail to return to good standing by the end of the probationary period.
