Position:

The College of Liberal Arts invites applications for a tenure-track, 10-month Assistant Professor position in the Department of Political Science beginning August 2018.

Qualifications:

PhD in hand at the time of application will receive preference, although ABDs may be considered if the degree will be completed by the Spring of 2018. Strong commitment to excellence in teaching and show a solid potential for a productive scholarly program. Interest in pursuing external funding is desired.

Responsibilities:

Teach general survey courses in international relations and upper-level courses focused on the international relations of developing countries. The ability to teach international political economy and/or comparative politics in the applicant's region of specialization would be an asset. Faculty assigned an instructional workload of six (6) course units per academic year for the first year. Beginning the second year the workload reverts back to the standard instructional workload of seven to eight (7-8) course units per academic year. While the position is tenured within the Political Science Department, the successful applicant will contribute three courses per year to the university's International Studies Program.
