Applicants will need to demonstrate potential for strong research, excellent teaching, and service aligned with the college's expected outcomes of impact, innovation and engagement.

**Responsibilities:**

Faculty assigned an instructional workload of six (6) course units per academic year in entrepreneurship and business & society areas, such as Social Entrepreneurship, Business Ethics, and Entrepreneurship & Society. Faculty member is expected to pursue research leading to refereed journal publications in the field of entrepreneurship, corporate social responsibility, and business & society. Faculty member is expected to engage in service to the department, college, university, community and professional associations. The successful candidate will join a department that is committed to students' excellence, innovative experiential teaching, and scholarly productivity.
