1. DAY CLASSES

Final exams for day classes (*start time prior to 4 p.m.*) meeting more than once a week are held according to the published day and hour of the first meeting of the class.

2. EVENING CLASSES

Final exams for evening classes (*start time 4 p.m. or later*) meeting more than once a week are held on the day that falls first during final exam week. *For example, since exams begin on Tuesday, a Tues/Thurs evening class would hold its exam on Tuesday.*

3. OFF MATRIX

Classes scheduled "off matrix" are to hold final exams according to the regularly scheduled meeting times they fall within, based on start time.

For example, classes scheduled on Tuesday or Thursday with a start time of 1 p.m. fall within the regularly scheduled time of 12:30-1:45 p.m. Exams for these classes are to follow the exam schedule of classes scheduled T/Th 12:30-1:45 p.m.

Similarly, a class that meets one day a week, such as Friday with a start time of 8 a.m., would follow the schedule for MWF 8-8:50 a.m.

4. SATURDAY CLASSES

Saturday exams will be held on Dec 12, 2020 at the regularly scheduled class meeting time.

5. *COMMON EXAMS

In addition to regularly scheduled Saturday class exams, selected departments will deliver common final exams.

6. FREE PERIODS

FREE time periods are used for university emergencies only. If the university postpones a final exam day or time, the exams will be rescheduled for the next available FREE time period.
