Once possibly the largest private home in America by 1790, the Hampton mansion serves as a grand example of late-Georgian architecture in America. Hampton is also the story of its people, as the estate evolved through the actions of the Ridgely family, enslaved African Americans, European indentured servants, and paid laborers within a nation struggling to define its own concept of freedom. Free tours provided at 1 p.m., 2 p.m., and 3 p.m., transportation to the site is not provided. Please note that there is a maximum limit of 15 people per tour. Tours are available on a first come, first serve basis. Individual reservations will not be taken. Tours run approximately 45-60 minutes.
