Position Overview:

 Officiate Intramural Sports contests including: basketball, flag football, futsal, soccer, kickball, and volleyball. Maintain a high sense of integrity while consistently and fairly enforcing the rules of the game. No prior experience is required, as training will be provided.

Position Duties and Responsibilities:

- Attend all required meetings and trainings
- Referee Intramural Sports games
- Enforce all Intramural Sports rules and policies
- Set up the activity area at the beginning of every shift
- Examine the playing surface before every game to ensure safe playing conditions
- Use appropriate signals and mechanics
- Maintain a high level of sportsmanship, and penalize unsporting behavior
- Communicate any problems or concerns to the supervisor
- Provide sportsmanship ratings after each Intramural Sports contest to the supervisor
- Maintain Intramural Sports equipment
- Breakdown the activity area at the end of every shift
- Provide excellent customer service to participants
- Resolve conflict within the frame of Intramural Sports competition
- Accept feedback from Supervisors and look to improve each shift

Qualifications:

- Must be able to lift/carry/move at least 40 pounds
- Must be able to run and stand for extended periods of time
- Will be exposed to variety of weather conditions, including: heat, cold, rain, wind, snow, etc.
