

# Akindi

## Linking Akindi to Blackboard

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Akindi allows you to set up an answer key online, and print out bubble sheets for your students to use. Once the students have taken the test, you can upload the student answer sheets by scanning them in and sending them to Akindi. Akindi will then grade the tests and provide you with a report, and can send the grades back to Blackboard for your students to see.

### *Linking Akindi to Blackboard*

This step only needs to be done once per course. However, this link needs to be created for each Blackboard course in order to use Akindi for that course.

1. Log into Blackboard and enter your course
2. Enter a **Content Area**
3. Select **Tools**, then **Akindi**
4. Enter a **name**. We recommend using "Akindi"
5. Scroll down to the **Options** header
6. Change the **Permit Users to View this Content** option from Yes to **No**  
**Please Note:** There is no student access in Akindi. Changing this option to No prevents students from seeing the link and attempting to open it.
7. Click **Submit**

### *Accessing Akindi*

1. Click on the name of the Akindi link inside of your course
2. Click **Launch Akindi**
3. You will be taken to the **Class Roster** page. Here, you'll see a list of the students enrolled in your Blackboard course
4. On the left, you'll see a list of all your **Courses** that have been created in Akindi. You can move between them by clicking on each course.
