Adding a Lynda.com Course (video) to Your Blackboard Site

1. Enter the Course you'd like add your **Lynda.com** Course to.
2. Choose any **Content Area** (ex: Information, Content).
3. Click on **Build Content** at the top of the screen.
4. Select **lynda.com Course** under **Mashups**.
5. Search for your video and hover your mouse over the thumbnail. Click the white **Add** button that appears in the center.
6. A **Course Details** screen will appear.

7. You will now get an option to turn on grading. To do this to under **Grading**, next to **Enable Grading** select **Yes**.

Please Note: Grading will create a column in the Grade Center. This is a percentage based column. As the students watch the videos related to the Lynda.com Course, the percentage will increase. This column will be added to the student's final grade for the course, unless you change the grade center column to Not Include in **Grade Center Calculations**.

8. Select **Yes** beside **Visible to Students** to make available for students.
9. Click **Save** at the bottom of the screen.

Please Note: Once the Lynda.com Course is added to your Blackboard site, you will see a dropdown arrow next to it. Clicking the drop down arrow will show an option to **Edit**. This option will give you an error as you are **not** able to edit the video. This is a known issue.
